

All about the location

Hints of History

The name of the town first appears in a document of 937 as Garniano, perhaps derived from the Latin personal Garenius. Documents by Titus Livy and tombstones, testify to the presence of Etruscans, Celts, Cenomani and Romans.

From 1350 to 1426 the territory of Gargnano was the domain of the Viscontis as the capital of quadra in the Magnifica Patria, and then followed its history under the rule of the Republic of Venice. After the disappearance of the Serenissima, it was annexed to the Brescian Republic, whose fate it followed under Napoleonic rule, as canton capital, and then Habsburg until the Kingdom of Italy.

In 1943 Gargnano hosted Mussolini, who arrived there on October 10, where he occupied, in the locality of San Giacomo, Villa Feltrinelli (now a luxury hotel). The Duce, who had recently established the Italian Social Republic, lived in the villa with his wife, Donna Rachele, and children Romano and Anna Maria

Location and climate

The municipality of Gargnano is located on the Brescia side of Lake Garda, which is 40 km from the provincial capital Brescia.

The climate is mild throughout the year and very comfortable. On wonderful spring days one can witness the triumph of nature in bloom, in summer the light breeze mitigates the high temperatures, autumn offers enchanting sunny days, and even in winter the temperatures remain pleasant.

Natural beauties in the surroundings

Garda Island, the largest island on the entire Lake Garda, belongs to the municipality of San Felice del Benaco. On the island is the luxurious palace of the Cavazza family, surrounded by beautiful Italian gardens and a rich forest composed of cypresses, acacias, and pines. Guided tours of this breathtaking island are organized with the Cavazza family between April and October. Feel the heavenly atmosphere of this small island on your skin.

The Heller Botanical Garden and the Vittoriale degli Italiani are popular destinations for visitors from all over the world. The mountains above, by the way easily accessible on foot, offer breathtaking scenery.

Garda's culinary arts

Various are the excellent restaurants in the area but the most renowned are :Lido 84 (starred restaurant), Villa Feltrinelli, II Pirata, Le Fay and excellent pizzerias.

Lake Garda sports

Lake Garda is known for water sports, first and foremost sailing with the important regattas that take place every year in the Benaco waters, but also wakeboarding (water



skiing), kitesurfing, windsurfing, canoeing, snorkeling, not forgetting the hottest water sport of the moment: stand up paddling (SUP).

Thrill-seekers can experience the thrill of hang gliding and paragliding from the top of Mount Spino and Mount Baldo.

A variety of golf courses can be reached within 15 km ,Bogliaco, Arzaga, Garda Golf, and Colombaro.

Walks, bicycle rides or horseback rides will make your experiences magical, there are more than 100 km of bicycle paths going from the lakeside to hillside trails.

For snow lovers, the prestigious resort of Madonna di Campiglio can be reached in just under two hours by car.
