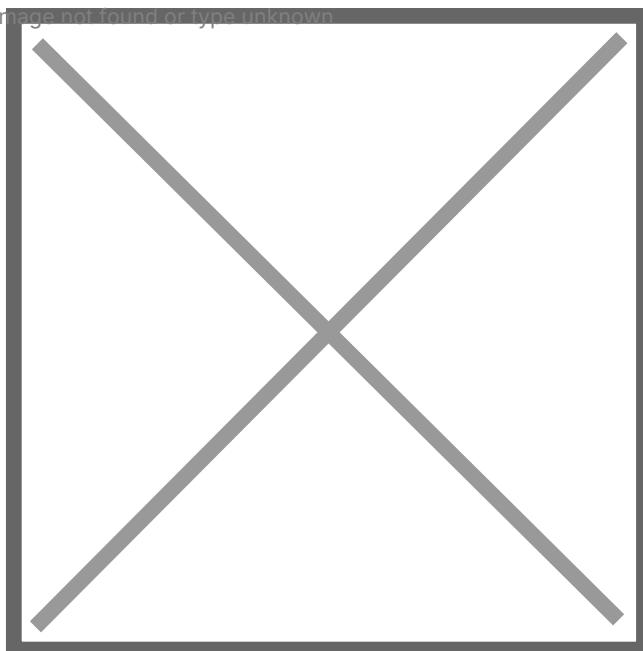

## Une première impression

This distinguished neoclassical residence, once home to Athenian high society, spans 231.59 sq.m., with an additional 104 sq.m. on the lower level (totaling 335.59 sq.m.). The lower level, with a separate entrance next to the main entry, offers privacy and versatility, ideal for a guest suite, service quarters, a secondary kitchen, and a bathroom.

Through its grand double doors, guests are welcomed into the elevated ground floor (94.79 sq.m.), reached by a few marble steps. The soaring 3.7-meter-high ceilings, majestic wooden staircase, and elegant columns define an atmosphere of sophistication and grandeur. After renovation, the space will embrace an art nouveau aesthetic, creating refined seating and dining areas. A cozy fireplace adds warmth and character, while the kitchen opens onto a charming courtyard at the rear of the house.

The first floor (104.28 sq.m.) features a magnificent master bedroom, bathed in natural light, with large windows and a balcony. This spacious retreat boasts an impressive en-suite bathroom. Two additional, well-appointed bedrooms on this level share a stylish bathroom, offering comfort and elegance.

The second floor houses a delightful penthouse space (32.52 sq.m.), perfect for a study or casual lounge, leading to an expansive terrace. Here, under the endless blue Athenian sky by day or the twinkling stars on warm summer nights, the city unfolds like a living museum, blending past and present in a mesmerizing dance of history and culture.
